



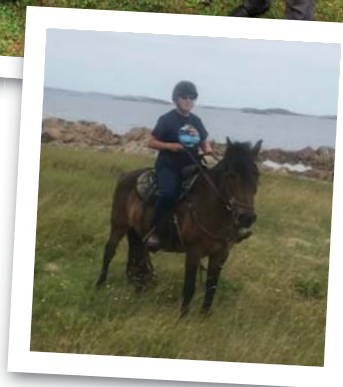
Making Dreams Come True
